Back to the Sea Society Policy

MEMBERSHIP TO THE SOCIETY -

BOARD APPROVED VIA EMAIL ON FEBRUARY 19, 2020

In accordance with our by-laws, membership in the Society shall consist of:

- the minimum of the 5 subscribers to the Memorandum of Association
- individuals, corporations or societies who subscribe to the objectives of the Society
- those who pay the annual membership fee in an amount to be determined by the Society
- honorary members appointed by the board.

While we do not have an annual membership fee, purchasers of a season pass to the Touch Tank Hut or the future Back to the Sea Aquarium will be members of the Society until the start of the following season. A group season pass is deemed to be one member and the group may designate any individual as its voting representative.

Additionally, any person donating a minimum of \$25 in a given year is a member. Any corporation or society donating a minimum of \$100 in a given year is deemed to be one member. Membership expires after the AGM until a new donation has been made.

Volunteers contributing a minimum of 6 hours in a given year are also voting members. Membership expires at the start of every season until hours have been accumulated once again.

The following is also stated in our by-laws.

- A corporation or a society is deemed to be one member and may designate any individual as its representative at any members' meetings. In the event that the designated representative is also a voting member of the Society, that individual may only cast one vote in respect of any motion.
- Membership in the Society is not transferable.
- Membership in the Society shall cease:
 - o upon death, or
 - o if the member resigns by written notice to the Society, or
 - if the member ceases to qualify for membership in accordance with the by-laws, or
 - if, by a vote of the majority of the members of the society or a majority vote of the Directors of the Society at a meeting duly called and for which notice of the proposed action has been given, the Member's membership in the Society has been terminated.
- Every member is entitled to attend any members' meeting of the Society.

- Every voting member subject to by-law 4 shall have one vote and no more and there shall not be proxy voting.
- Members who are minors shall be non-voting members.
- No funds of the society shall be paid to or be available for the personal benefit of any member.
